## Order

- On February 20, 2025, the Clerk of the Court received the transcript and exhibit volumes. Exhibit Volume 8 contains the audio/video exhibits. Although the Clerk of the Court has received an electronic version of Exhibit Volume 8, a conventional physical version of Exhibit Volume 8 has not been received.
- Appellate Rule 29(B) provides that audio/video exhibits should be submitted in a conventional physical volume saved on a CD/DVD/flash drive and that this volume should be transmitted (i.e. mailed) to the Appellate Clerk the same time the transcript and documentary exhibits are filed. Thus, audio/video exhibits should not be retained by the trial clerk and should be mailed to the Appellate Clerk the same day the transcript and documentary exhibits are filed.
- Appellant has filed a Petition for Order to Clerk and for Extension of Time to File Brief.

- [4] Having reviewed the matter, the Court finds and orders as follows:
  - 1. Appellant's Petition for Order to Clerk and for Extension of Time to File Brief is granted.
  - 2. Within five (5) days of the date of this order, the Vermillion Circuit Court Clerk is directed to transmit a conventional physical version of Exhibit Volume 8 to the Clerk of this Court.
  - 3. Appellant's Brief is due within thirty (30) days of the date the conventional exhibit volume is transmitted to the Clerk of this Court. Appellant may obtain access to Exhibit Volume 8 through the Appellate Clerk.
  - 4. The Clerk of this Court is directed to send this order to the parties, the trial court, and the Vermillion Circuit Court Clerk.
  - 5. The Vermillion Circuit Court Clerk is directed to file this order under Cause Number 83C01-2310-F6-111, and, pursuant to Indiana Trial Rule 77(D), the Clerk shall place the contents of this order in the Record of Judgments and Orders.
