**AFFIDAVIT**

The undersigned upon oath deposes and states as follows, to-wit;  
That your Affiant, Jeffery Williams, is a certified and commissioned Police Officer in and for the City of Duncan, Stephens County, Oklahoma and is currently assigned to the Patrol Division.


On November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020, at approximately 0203 hours, F.T.O. Lard and I were traveling south bound on highway 81 from Main Street. I observed in my driver side review mirror a vehicle, bearing Oklahoma license plate HLZ454, traveling north bound on highway 81 having a defective tag light. I turned north bound on 81 and activated my emergency lights on my patrol vehicle initiating a traffic stop on said vehicle at highway 81 and Hickory.

I exited my patrol vehicle and made contact with the driver, later identified as Heather Chandler. I asked chandler for her license and proof of insurance. I observed Chandler had slow deliberate movements while searching for her license and insurance. I returned to my patrol vehicle and F.T.O. Lard advised he also observed Chandler having slow deliberate movement. I made a 2<sup>nd</sup> approach to the vehicle and asked Chandler if she had anything to drink, she stated: "I had 3 beers."

I instructed Chandler to exit the vehicle so I could administer Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. Upon exiting the vehicle I observed Chandler was unsteady on her feet. I administered the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus test on Chandler and observed the following 4 clues: lack of smooth pursuit in both Chandler's right and left eye, distinct nystagmus at maximum deviation in Chandler's left and right eye. During the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus test I observed Chandler swaying left to right and droopy eyelids. I explained and demonstrated the Walk and Turn test 2 times. I observed the following 8 clues: couldn't keep balance during instruction, starts too soon, stops while walking, misses heel to toe, steps off line, uses arms to balance, improper turn, and wrong number of steps. I explained and demonstrated the One Leg Stand test. I observed the following 3 clues: swaying, uses arms for balance, and puts foot down. During the One Leg Stand test Chandler had difficulty counting in the prescribed manner.

At approximately 0233 hours, I placed Chandler under arrest and escorted her to my patrol vehicle, where I read her the states implied consent test request. Chandler refused to give an answer. I read the states implied consent test request again and Chandler refused to answer. I transported Chandler to the Stephens County Jail where she was given another opportunity to take the states test. At the jail in Chandler's purse I discovered a pill bottle having Chandlers name on it and it contained a single blue oval pill with "ALEVE" inscribed on it later identified as Aleve, (6) white oval pills with "M367" inscribed on them later identified as Acetaminophen and Hydrocodone Bitartrate, (2) partial white oval pills with "67" inscribed on them, (2) white circular pills with "SG109" inscribed on them later identified as carisoprodol, 1 partial white circular pill with "S109" inscribed on it, 1 blue circular pill with "C1" inscribed on it later identified as clonazepam, 1 partial blue circular pill with "C" inscribed on it, 1 white circular pill with "M" inscribed on one side and "4" inscribed on the other side later identified as acetaminophen and codeine phosphate, 1 partial circular white pill with a partial "M" inscribed on one side, and 1 partial white circular pill. Also in Chandler's purse I discovered 2 small clear baggies containing a white crystalline substance, 1 small pink baggie containing a white crystalline substance, and a small baggie containing a green leafy substance. At the police department the clear small baggies tested positive for the presumptive evidence of methamphetamine and the green leafy substance was booked into property. Chandler was booked into the Stephens County jail for the district charges of **DUI REFUSAL, POSSESION OF CDS, AND DEFECTIVE EQUIPMENT.** Chandler's vehicle was released to Precision wrecker.

Based upon this information, the undersigned prays that this Honorable Court issue a finding of fact that probable cause exists to believe that a crime has been committed and that there is probable cause to believe the defendant(s) above named committed that crime.
