4. That for good cause shown, the Motion should be granted.

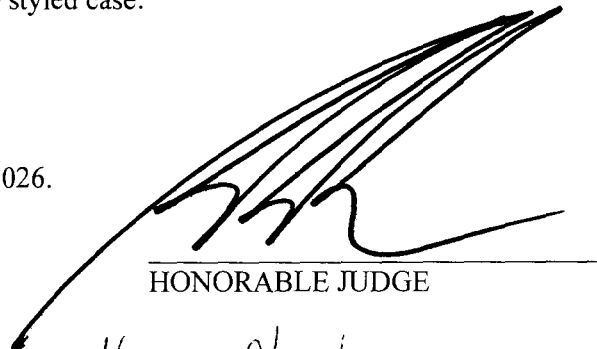
