This report is submitted in response to a Motion to Modify Conditions of Probation initiated by the defendant. In accordance with Rule 27.4(3), the probation officer is required to provide this Investigation Report before any modification of probation can be considered.

Case Overview:

The defendant was placed on three (3) years of probation on July 1, 2025, with two cases running concurrently: Count 14, Stalking Distress/Fear, a Class Five Felony, and Count 1, Aggravated Harassment, a Class Six Felony. He has completed one year and fifteen days of probation. A review of online court records and criminal history indicates no known new criminal activity.

Compliance with Probation Conditions/Current Status:

The defendant was on the Compliance Monitoring Caseload, since July 1, 2025. He has committed violations as pertaining to the victim. He is self-employed as a social media influencer.

Defendant's Response to Court-Ordered Assessments:

Restitution was not ordered in this case. The defendant's remaining balance is \$0.00.

Probation Officer's Recommendation:

The APD does object to the defendant's motion requesting to Modify Conditions of Probation. Should the Court wish to grant this motion, a Criminal Restitution Order is respectfully requested for any outstanding fines and fees.
