

**ENTRY OF APPEARANCE, MOTION FOR DISCOVERY
AND INVOCATION OF CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS**

COMES NOW, May & Associates, and hereby enters their appearance in the above-styled and numbered cause of action as attorney for the Defendant.

Defendant hereby formally invokes his right to remain silent under the 5th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution as interpreted by the U.S. Supreme Court in *Miranda v. Arizona*, 384 U.S. 436, and informs Plaintiff that he is exercising his right not to speak to officers, investigators, psychiatrists, or any person other than those working for the Defense.

Defendant also specifically requests any audio or video footage from dashcams, bodycams, or other sources related to this case. Counsel for Defendant will pay for the cost of any reproduction or provide media for the digital transfer of said documents upon request.
